# **NSF Major Research Instrumentation / Call for Pre-Proposals**

This call for pre-proposals is for the National Science Foundation <u>Major Research</u> <u>Instrumentation Program (NSF MRI)</u> grant opportunity. The MRI program awards grants for the acquisition or development of research instruments. It focuses on multi-user/shared instrumentation that often supports research needs across disciplinary boundaries. **Preproposals are due by Friday, September 6th, 2024.**  The UNI Office of Research and Sponsored Programs is conducting an internal preproposal competition to select up to two Track 1 proposals (requesting up to \$1.4 million), one Track 2 proposal (requesting up to \$4 million), and one Track 3 proposal (for equipment that reduces helium consumption) that will be submitted from UNI. Preproposals in all NSF funded areas will be considered. For more information about this opportunity see the <u>RSP website</u>.

### **Responsible Conduct of Research**

Anyone conducting research at UNI will benefit from the Responsible Conduct of Research classes offered through UNI's CITI subscription service. Those who are supported by grants funded with the NSF, NIH and NIFA are required to complete RCR training before any effort can be charged to the grant. RCR training expires every three years.

## **Institutional Review Board**

Here are a few IRB tips as you begin the year!


- If you are conducting human subjects research for the first time, you must <u>obtain</u> <u>Human Subjects Training.</u> This must be done in advance of your IRB submission.
- Remember to <u>certify</u> your submission in Cayuse. Submissions that are not certified do not enter the workflow for review. Check your study status in Cayuse or reach out to the IRB Administrator if you need assistance.
- <u>Monthly meetings and IRB submission cut off dates</u> for proposals requiring full review have been scheduled. These meetings are only for proposals that require full committee review.

- UNI reviews all research involving human subjects. Investigators may not make their own exempt determinations.
